1.2 Functions and duties:

1.2.1 The Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission was constituted vide G.O. Ms.No. 65, Energy (Power III) dated 31-3-99 as an independent statutory body under the provisions of A.P. Electricity Reform Act, 1998. The Commission comprises a Chairman and two Members, appointed by the Government of A.P. as per the selection procedure prescribed in the Reform Act. The Commission became operational w.e.f. 3 - 4 - 1999.

1.2.2 The Electricity Act, 2003, came into force w.e.f 10-06-03. While repealing the three earlier Acts viz., the Indian Electricity Act, 1910, the Electricity (Supply) Act, 1948 and the Electricity Regulatory Commissions Act, 1998, the new Act saved the AP Electricity Reform Act, 1998, and the provisions of the Reform Act, not inconsistent with the provisions of the new Act will continue to apply in the State of AP. Section 86 of the Electricity Act

2003 enumerates the functions of the State Electricity Regulatory Commission.

1.2.3 The main functions of the Commission are:-

- To aid and advise, the State Government, in matters concerning generation, transmission, distribution and supply of electricity in the State;
- To regulate the working of licensees and to promote their working in an efficient, economical and equitable manner;
- To issue licences in accordance with the provisions of the Act(s);
- To determine the tariff for generation, supply, transmission and wheeling of electricity;
- To regulate electricity purchases and procurement process of Distribution Licensees including the price for the electricity to be purchased;
- To facilitate intra-state transmission and wheeling of electricity;
- To promote co-generation and generation of electricity from renewable sources of energy;
- To adjudicate upon the disputes between the licensees and generating companies;
- To fix the trading margin in the intra-state trading of electricity if considered necessary; and

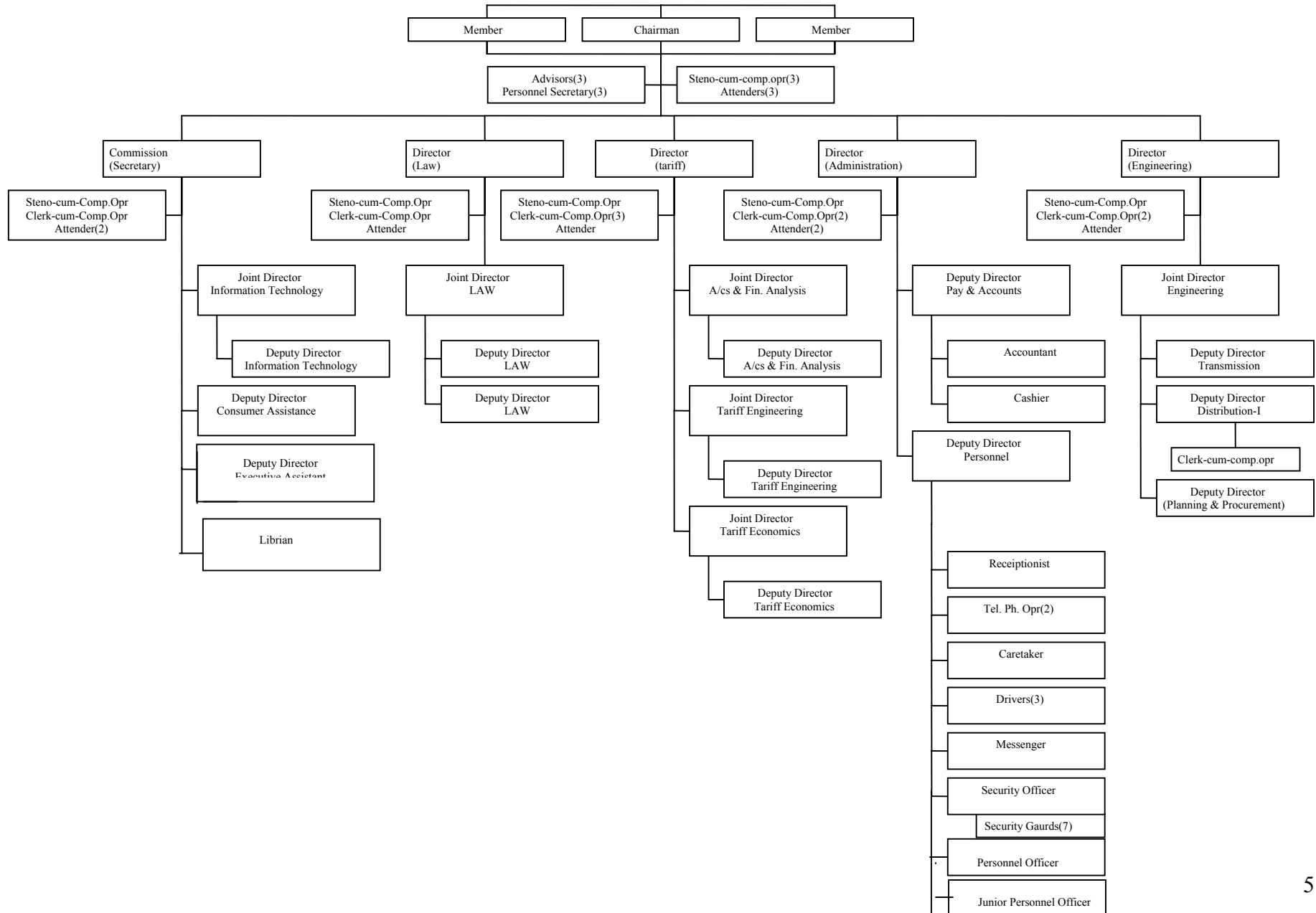
- To specify the standards with respect to quality, continuity and reliability of service by Licensees.

1.2.4 In discharge of its functions the Commission shall be guided by the National Electricity Policy, National Electricity Plan, and tariff policy notified by Government of India u/s 3 of Electricity Act 2003.

2) Powers and duties of officers and employees of APERC

In discharge of its functions and duties, the Commission is assisted by the Commission Secretary, Director (Tariff), Director (Engg.), Director (Law) and Director (Admn.) who are domain specialists and supported by concerned Joint Directors, Dy. Directors etc. The organization chart is shown below:

The above officers are assisted by the Supporting Staff such as P.S.s, PAs, SCOs, CCOs, Security Officer and Office Subordinates etc.

3) The Procedure followed in the decisions- making process, including channels of supervision and accountability

APERC is a statutory Organisation established under the AP Electricity Reform Act, 1998 and continuing to function under The Electricity Act 2003. The Commission discharges its functions and duties by exercising the powers vested in it under the Act and as per the procedure laid down in the APERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 1999 (Regulation No.2 of 1999) as amended from time to time.

4) The norms set by APERC for the discharge of its functions:

The APERC established norms for Conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its functions and notified the same vide APERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 1999 (Regulation No. 2 1999) as amended from time to time.

5) The rules, regulations, instructions, manuals and records held by APERC and used by employees for discharging functions:

The Central Government as well as the State Governments are empowered to make rules under the provisions of the Electricity Act 2003, for carrying out the provisions of the Act. A list of such Rules and other notifications issued by the Gol is appended as Appendix-A and the list of Rules / Orders issued by Government of AP is appended as Appendix-B. Similarly, the Central Electricity Authority, the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission and the State Electricity Regulatory Commission are empowered under the Electricity Act 2003 for notifying various Regulations. The list of such regulations notified are appended as follows:

6) Statement of the categories of documents that are held by APERC or under its control:

The following categories of documents are available with the Commission:

- (i) Regulations made by APERC
- (ii) Orders issued by APERC on the petitions filed before it or suo moto.
- (iii) Proceedings issued by APERC in discharge of its functions/ duties under the Act.

All the Regulations, Orders and Proceedings issued by the Commission from time to time since its inception from 03-04-1999 are also available in the Commission's website www.ercap.org.

7) The particulars of any arrangement that exists for consultation with, or representation by, the members of the public in relation to the formulation of policy or implementation thereof.

Tariff Orders and orders for consent of PPAs of utilities involving purchases from Major Generating Stations are finalized by the Commission duly following the consultation process and public hearings. Public notices and press releases are issued to invite responses from interested persons and general public and public hearings are conducted to hear those who are desirous of being heard in person and the same are considered before finalization of the Tariff Orders.

Similarly, the draft Regulations for implementation of the provisions of the Act are pre-published as required under the Act for comments / suggestions from public and the responses received are considered by the Commission before notification of the Regulations.

- 8) **Statement of the boards, councils, committees and other bodies consisting of two or more persons constituted as its part or for the purpose of its advice, and as to whether meetings of those boards, councils, committees and other bodies are open to the public, or the minutes of such meetings are accessible for public.**

The State Advisory Committee constituted by the Commission u/s 87 of the Electricity Act, 2003 with 17 Members, including the Chairperson and Members of APERC, representing the interests of Commerce, Industry, Transport, Agriculture, Labour, Consumers, NGOs and academic and research bodies in the electricity sector. The SAC meets once in a quarter to advise the Commission on major questions of policy, quality of service provided by licensees, protection of consumer interests and standards of performance of licenses etc.

The Coordination Forum constituted by the State Government consisting of Chairperson and Members of the Commission and representatives of the generating companies, transmission licensee and distribution licensees for smooth and coordinated development of the power system in the State.
